IF YOU HAVE BEEN ASKED TO SUBSTITUTE PLEASE CHANGE THE NAME AND TICK

1. * where two ministers have an asterisk by your names
please alternate serving
Even after that you may still be needed in the end!
2. On Sundays please make sure that the main chalice and dish
have been brought from the altar for you to purify.
Servers usually remember but if not please make sure you cleanse them.

3. PURIFYING VESSELS

The Dish [Ciborium]

- swill water around the dish to collect any small fragments of the Host
- pour that into the chalice and drink that water
- **never** use your hand or the purificator to sweep the Host fragments

The Chalice

- consume any of the Precious Blood that remains
- if the quantity is too great ask other ministers to assist
- in some rarer cases the Chalice with the Precious Blood may be taken to the Tabernacle.
- swill water around the chalice to collect any drops of the Precious Blood & fragments of the Host
- use your finger with some of the water to clean the rim of the chalice where people have drunk
- dry the chalice with the purificator
- fold the purificator back into three and put it across the chalice
- on weekdays in the chapel – put the dish on top the chalice
the pall and corporal on top of the dish, and cover with the chalice veil.

4. TABERNACLE KEY

If you are going to the tabernacle it is important for you to insist
that a server opens the door to the chapel
and brings you the tabernacle key. You cannot do both!
Obviously if there is no server you must do it alone.

NOTES

Reader 1 to join Entrance Procession.

Pick up the Book of the Gospels and carry it closed,
keeping the marker to the side of the book

Walking up the aisle, go to the right of the Altar.

Walk up the side steps and place the Book in the centre.

Bow with the priest and ministers.

*After Mass Reader 1 should return the Book of the Gospels
to the Evangelarium in the Narthex, open at the right page.*

Reader 2 goes to the ambo when the bell rings three times.

Wait for all to stand, then lead the Parish Prayer.

Introduce the Mass [and the Processional Hymn].

Readers 1 and 2 come together at the centre and bow if possible in time with the priest.

When you arrive at Church (at least 10 mins before Mass) to read,
please advise the celebrant that you are there,
tick your name off the rota in the church porch.

If there are 3 readers, Readers 1 and 3 take one of the readings each,.

Please check before Mass for any change to procedure by looking in the intercessions book

Can all Ministers please remember to put the book on the shelf of the lectern after the 2nd reading
underneath the black bidding prayer folder
