NOTES for BOTH READERS and EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU TICK THE ROTA AS YOU COME INTO MASS TO SEE IF WE NEED MORE MINISTERS.
IF YOU HAVE BEEN ASKED TO SUBSTITUTE PLEASE CHANGE THE NAME AND TICK
PLEASE SEE FATHER KEVIN IF YOU HAVE A SUGGESTION FOR SOMEONE TO JOIN EITHER TEAM.

NOTES for EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS

1. On Sundays please make sure that the main chalice and dish have been brought from the altar for you to purify. Servers usually remember but if not please make sure you cleanse them.

2. PURIFYING VESSELS

The Dish [Ciborium]

- **NEVER** use your hand or the purificator to sweep the Host fragments
- **ALWAYS** swill water around the dish to collect any small fragments of the Host
- pour that into the chalice and drink that water

The Chalice

- consume any of the Precious Blood that remains
 - if the quantity is too great ask other ministers to assist
 - in some rarer cases the Chalice with the Precious Blood may be taken to the Tabernacle.
 - swill water around the chalice to collect any drops of the Precious Blood & fragments of the Host
 - use your finger with some of the water to clean the rim of the chalice where people have drunk
 - dry the chalice with the purificator
 - fold the purificator back into three and put it across the chalice
 - **on weekdays in the chapel** – put the purificator on top of the chalice then the dish.
- Place the pall and corporal on top of the dish, and cover with the chalice veil neatly.

3. TABERNACLE KEY

If you are going to the tabernacle it is important for you to insist that a server opens the door to the chapel and brings you the tabernacle key. **You cannot do both!**
Obviously if there is no server you must do it alone.

NOTES FOR READERS

Prepare the readings and texts – available on the website. Check the intercessions/introduction.
If there are 3 readers, Readers 1 and 3 take one of the readings each,.

INTRODUCTION AND PROCESSION

Reader 1 joins Entrance Procession carrying the Lectionary against your chest, **not elevated**.

Walking up the aisle, go to the left of the Altar. Place the Lectionary on the Ambo, open it at the right page.

Reader 2 goes to the ambo when the bell rings three times. Wait for all to stand, then lead the Parish Prayer.

Introduce the Mass [and the Processional Hymn], and move to the bench

Readers 1 and 2 come together at the centre and bow if possible in time with the priest.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

Readers 1 [and 2 – not if the psalm is being sung] go forward after the Opening Prayer, bow in the centre and go to the lectern [and bench].

After the second reading put the book on the shelf of the lectern underneath the black bidding prayer folder

When the readings are over they return in the same way as they came.

INTERCESSIONS

Reader 2 comes forward for the Intercessions at the end of the Creed, bows and goes to the Lectern.

After the concluding prayer Reader 2 comes to the centre, and wait to bow with the priest and server.

After Mass Reader 1 returns the Book of the Gospels to the Evangeliarium in the Narthex, open at the right page.
